HUBY VILLAGE WALKS No 9 EASINGWOLD GOLF COURSE TO HUBY

DISTANCE/TIME: $3^{1}/_{3}$ miles: 1hour 20

minutes

TERRAIN: Field footpaths, farm tracks and

lanes, some road.

From the village shop, take the 40 bus in the direction of Easingwold.


- 1. Alight at the golf course and go through the car park, keeping the clubhouse on your right.
- 2. Continue onto a track which turns left, marked by white posts.
- 3. Bear left past one shed and continue with the driving range on your left then the golf course to your right.
- 4. Cross the concrete bridge and continue with a beck on the left, then trees to the right.
- 5. At the corner, follow the arrow to the right and go straight ahead through a metal gate and then a field gate.
- 6. Follow the arrow to the left along a tarmac lane to the wrought iron gates.

- 7. The footpath goes through a small gate on the left and bears right on to Green Lane.
- 8. At the white stones follow footpath sign to right to Graycarr

Lodge Farm.

- 9. Pass the old combine shed on your right and follow the arrow straight ahead to left, then an arrow to the right. Keep the hedge on your left.
- 10. Here you can take the footpath left through the woods to the road, or continue straight ahead onto a track, which leads you round the edge of the woods and onto Easingwold Road nearer to the village.
- 11. Turn right onto Easingwold Road back to the village.

The Club House Café is open to the public.

FASCINATING FACTS

Huby's name means 'farmstead on a spur of land', an 8th/10th century Danish name. You can see houses in Main St. have been built on a small ridge.

WW1 plaque set in the wall of the Methodist Chapel by the bus stop gives the names of the 5 men of Huby, J. A. Cundall, W.H. Hebdon, T.W. Hardiman, G. Hayden, & W. F. Yorke. who died in the Great War.

Tom Dresser VC is also commemmorated on a stone set in the ground at the front of the Chapel. He was a Huby man and was awarded his medal for his great act of bravery in 1917, in conveying a message, while wounded, to the front line. He survived and died in 1982 in Middlesbrough.

Easingwold Golf Course was opened in 1930, having been designed by Hawtree architects, a renowned family of golf course architects. It is an 18 hole golf course across woodland and heath. There are 15,000 mature trees across the area.

The footpath into Folly Wood and then past Cass Plantation forms the parish boundary between Stillington and Huby.

Sand used to be dug from the area where Oak Tree House, formerly a sawmill, is situated. Easingwold Road or Sand Lane is built mainly on sand.
